

About Mr. Singer

Mr. Singer was born in Canton, Ohio on November 15, 1955. He grew up in North Canton, Ohio and graduated from Hoover High School in 1974. He received his undergraduate degree in English Literature from George Washington University in 1978. He received his law degree from the University of Akron in 1983.

Shortly after graduation, Mr. Singer relocated to Florida and began his legal career in Florida working as an Assistant Public Defender in the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit. He was employed as a public defender from November 1983 through April 1986. In April 1986 Mr. Singer began work with the law firm of Kane, Singer, Planck, Donoghue, Clark and Mixson. Mr. Singer was a partner in that firm until January 1999. The firm concentrated exclusively on insurance defense work in Central Florida and the Treasure Coast.

In January 1999 Mr. Singer shifted the focus of his practice to the representation of injured people. After working from 1999 to 2002 as a sole practitioner, he formed a partnership with Kathryn B. Johnston and worked in the firm of Singer & Johnston from July 2002 until July 2011. During this period, he limited his practice exclusively to the representation of injured people.

In 2011, Mr. Singer was certified as a Florida Supreme Court Certified Circuit Civil Mediator. In July 2011 he became associated with the firm of Mediate First and currently limits his practice to the mediation of all types of claims with the exception of claims involving family law issues.

Mr. Singer is a member of the Florida Bar as well as the Brevard county bar Association. He also is a member of the American Board of trial Advocates (ABOTA), and he was awarded the Brevard County Bar Association Professionalism Award in 2009. Additionally, he served as a member of the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit Grievance Committee from December 2006 until December 2009.
